Dear Mr. Gustafson:

This letter is to inform you that DaVita Labs located at 3951 SW 30th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312, is shutting down completely and being relocated to a new location. Eventually the entirety of the location will close. This action is expected to be permanent.

DaVita Labs will conduct employee separations in connection with this action in phases. As communicated on October 8th, 2018, the first employee separations in connection with the facility shutting down are expected to commence on January 1, 2019 (the "separation date"). The fourth phase separation date is April 1, 2019. Enclosed is a listing of the job titles of the positions to be affected in the fourth phase, as well as the number of affected employees in each job classification and the affected employees' anticipated separation dates.

There are no bumping rights for the affected employees. The affected employees at this facility are not represented by any union.
